RICHARD (DICK) BISHOP 1929 - 2004

Dick Bishop arrived in Morwell in 1961 to teach art at Morwell Technical School and by 1967 established the Diploma of Art course. In 1984 he also established TAFE courses in Applied Art in Newborough and initiated 'The Jason Club', the forerunner of the Latrobe Regional Gallery Friends group. Bishop officially retired in 1988 but remained involved in the Moe Heritage Art Group and was a mentor to a group he called 'The Dead Wombat Society' up until his passing in 2004. Throughout his life he was passionate about supporting emerging artists, and this prize is an ongoing recognition of his commitment.

PRIZE

The successful applicant will receive a curated exhibition at Latrobe Regional Gallery, to be held **15 July - 6 August 2017**.

WHO CAN APPLY?

The Dick Bishop Memorial Prize is open to emerging artists of any age.

Individuals or groups who are **current full time residents of Gippsland** may apply.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Send in the following:

- A completed entry form.
- A written exhibition proposal (maximum one page).
- A CV (maximum two pages).
- List of works you propose to exhibit including title, year, medium and dimensions.
- Visual support material (maximum 10 images). CD or USB of digital images in jpg format, 300 dpi. Photos will also be accepted.

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

- The applicant must currently reside in Gippsland on a full time basis.
- Artworks in any medium will be accepted.
- The majority of work submitted for assessment must be the same work that will be exhibited.
- Entries must be work produced within the 12 months prior to entry date.
- Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- The successful applicant must abide by the Latrobe Regional Gallery guidelines.
- The recipient of this prize will receive a curated exhibition, with decisions made at the discretion of the Senior and Assistant Curators.

WHO SELECTS THE WORK?

The prize winner will be selected by the Director, Senior Curator and Assistant Curator. Guest judges may be included at Latrobe Regional Gallery's discretion.

The selection panels decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The successful applicant will be notified by the **Monday 1 May 2017**. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified in writing.
