Leigh Hobba is a very significant artist in the development of Australian video art as both a teacher and as an artist. Hobba's work has both simplicity and uniqueness. His work demonstrates a capacity to distil the elements that go to make up our feeling of 'presence' and 'being'. We don't need to necessarily understand his work; "we just need to experience and to register its effect in our bodies".

ABOUT THE ACTIVITY:

Inspired by Leigh Hobba's artwork *Any Which Way* from his current exhibition, create your own floating rock drawing.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Select a rock drawing template, or draw your own large rock on a blank sheet of white paper
2. Colour and shade your rock to add texture, depth and mystery
3. Carefully cut out your rock
4. Glue your rock to a blank sheet of black paper
